

AMAZON RIVER MUYUNA 3 days/ 2 nights

MAY 2019

MON 20 LIMA - IQUITOS

Transfer from the airport to Iquitos (or hotel to the office) for shopping and last-minute coordination.

Transfer to the port.

Transfer in a fast boat for 3 hours, 140 kms. upriver from lquitos on the Amazon River. Distribution of bungalow and guidance.

Lunch.

Leoncito Hike, where you appreciate the immense variety of flora around the Muyuna area. You'll also be amazed at how huge the ceiba tree is. In addition, you will see the world's smallest monkey, the pigmy marmoset, the squirrel, the tamarin and the howler monkeys. whose deafening roar can be heard many miles away.

After watching a sunset over the forest of mirrors, back to Muyuna. Dinner.

In the evening, boat ride to see caimans, nocturnal birds and mammals.

TUE 21 IQUITOS

Breakfast.

We will take you to the Amazon River, where you will experience the most magical moment of your trip, which is to swim in the same river where the pink and gray dolphins live. You can see them, but, don't expect to touch. On the way back to the lodge, you will see the biggest aquatic plant in the world, the famous Victoria Regia. It is also easy to see iguanas. This is an area that has many strangler vines, being the favorite spot of the bird "hoatzin" or shansho. This colorful bird looks like a prehistoric bird because it has three claws on the middle joint of the wing.

Lunch.

Boat trips to the lakes Purura and Corriente and catch different kind of fish, including the famous piranha.

Dinner.

At night, you do a night walk in search of huge frogs, anaconda's favorite food. In addition to seeing tarantulas.

WED 22 IQUITOS - LIMA

Breakfast.

Boat trip to Lake Sapote watching different birds, like parrots, jacanas, kingfishers, herons, panguana, partridges, pigeons, cormorants, horned screamers, and then move to the other end of the Lake Moena where you can see sloth and monkeys, as the night monkey, squirrel, monk, stump, etc.

Lunch.

With your guide, you will be able to count all the animals seen in your Animal Check List. Your experience of the jungle comes to an end and you will sail three hours back to lquitos and take you to the hotel or airport.

Include

- Taxes.
- Transfer from the airport to the port or hotel in Iquitos.
- Boat trip from Iquitos to Muyuna Lodge on the Amazon River, 140 kilometers, for about 3 hours. Includes the return, as well.
- Visit remote local village to see how different life style the jungle people have. Muyuna does not make visits to tribes.
- Drinkable water.
- An aluminum bottle so you can refill water.
- Rubber boots.
- Electric supply for batteries from cameras, laptops, etc. at certain times.
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner. The menu is balanced between Peruvian and international food, so you can taste typical dishes in combination with mild flavors. We use small amou of salt, sugar and oil. We don't use monosodium glutamate (Aji-no-moto in Peru). If you are vegetarian or have restrictions on some food, please let us know in advance. The animal proteins we use are: pork, beef, fish, eggs, and chicken.
- There is a fruit basket and a coffee table at your disposal.
- Private bungalow with private bathroom and terrace with hammock facing the river or the jungle.
- Tents, mattresses and everything you need in case you want to camp in the middle of pristine jungle.
- Night and day activities to look for animals.
- Expert bilingual naturalist guides with small groups.
- A list of animals that can be found around the area of Muyuna.
- First aid kit, which includes serum against the poison snakes (no worries, we have not use one never).
- Having no TV, we offer travelers to play again like when we were kids. We were away from electronic games, so we count with Monopoly, Scrabble, Chess, etc. We have mini-soccer game and a ping pong table.
- Biodegradable amenities like: shampoo, conditioner, body lotion and liquid soap.

Not included:

- Airfare and airport taxes (however, we can help you organize the trip planning the route and buying the tickets more appropriate).
- Tips for guide and staff members.
- Tips for baggage handlers.
- Travel insurance or health insurance.
- Liquors and beverages.
- You can wash clothes, in coordination with the manager.





What to bring (think about mosquitoes):

Fortunately, there are no antennas for mobile phones near Muyuna, so you do not need to bring them. Because space is limited in the boat, bring only the luggage that is necessary to the jungle. The extra luggage can be stored in lquitos Muyuna office without any cost.
